ESQ. GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING.

KNOW YE, That by virtue and in consideration of *part a land office Military warrant N^o 1923 issued*
the 21st day of November 1783

there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto

William Croghan

a certain TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, containing *four hundred and fifty acres by survey bearing date*
the 18th day of December 1785 lying and being in the District set apart for the officers & soldiers
of the Virginia State Line on the North side of Big Barren river and bounded as followeth
to wit Beginning at two white oaks and hickory standing on a high bank of the river about a mile
below Drake's Creek and three quarters of a mile below Andrew McHargens ferry thence down the
river with its meanders S 74° E 20 paces S 6° E 20 paces S 83° E 50 paces S 66° E 80 paces S 30° E
20 paces S 60° E 100 paces N 66° E 30 paces N 28° E 40 paces N 28 paces N 27° E 30 paces N 120 paces N 20°
10 22 paces N 5° E 20 paces N 10° E 48 paces N 11° E 35 paces to a large ash hackberry & beech standing
on the river bank a small distance above a bluff thence S 71° E 360 paces to a stake, thence S 92°
paces to the Beginning

With its appurtenances: To have and to hold the said Tract or Parcel of Land, with its appurtenances, to the said *William Croghan*
and *his* heirs forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said *Edmund Randolph* Esq. Governor of the
Commonwealth of Virginia, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the lesser Seal of the said Common-
wealth to be affixed, at *Richmond* on the *thirteenth* day of *April*
in the year of our Lord one thousand *seven* hundred and *eighty seven* and of
the Commonwealth the *Eleventh*
