Be it known that I, Elizabeth Claypool Hilleary hereby accept a commission as Lieutenant in the Camp Shelby Brigade, in the City of Louisville, County of Jefferson, State of Kentucky, of the

being part of the National Woman's Liberty Loan Committee for the Eighth Federal Reserve District.

In accepting said commission I realize the necessity for such an organization and the importance of its service to the UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, and also the need for rules to govern its actions.

*I Therefore Pledge Myself* hereby

- (a) to serve to the best of my ability at any time I may be called upon, and particularly on October 1, 2, 3 and 4, 1918,
- (b) to obey all rules and directions of my superior officers,
- (c) to endeavor to sell bonds to every individual in the territory assigned to me, and
- (d) not to solicit or accept subscriptions for bonds outside of such territory in the intensive campaign for the sale of

## FOURTH LIBERTY LOAN BONDS

On said dates and for said purpose I agree to give all of my time or such time as may be required, as an assurance and renewal of my allegiance to my GOVERNMENT and to the CAUSE OF LIBERTY, and this I will in nowise omit; except for a cause over which I shall have no control.
