**TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:**

**KNOW YE,** That by virtue and in consideration of a Certificate, No. 504

State price paid with interest, granted by the County Court of *Barren* in 1802 agreeably to an Act of Assembly for settling and improving the Vacant Lands of this Commonwealth, there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto

*George Rushong*

a certain tract or parcel of land, containing *two hundred and fifty* acres, by survey.

bearing date the *eighth* day of *November*

*one thousand eight hundred and four*

lying and being in the County of *Barren* on the waters of the East fork of Big Barren river and bounded

as follows to wit: Beginning at Francis Harris's South East corner red oak and white oak thence *N 140 paces* with his line to his corner a red oak and two white oaks thence with another of his lines *West 60 paces* to a red oak thence *N 90° West 230 paces* to a stake, thence *East 40 paces* to a white oak thence the same course *East 220 paces* to a white oak and hickory thence *S 120 paces* to a chestnut and dogwood on John Harris's line thence with the same *West 120 paces* to his corner a chestnut black gum and dogwood thence with another of his lines *West 60 paces* to a chestnut and dogwood on John Harris's beginning corner thence *West 90 paces* to the Beginning

With its appurtenances: To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with its appurtenances, to the said *George Rushong*

and his heirs forever.
