Harri's line then with *Bishons line N 34°* to a white oak and hickory corner
to same then same course *45°* to a white oak then East *124°* to a black
oak then South *36°* East *200°* to a black oak then South *45°* West *200°* to
a forked chestnut then to the Beginning
