KNOW YE, That by virtue and in consideration of *part of a* Kentucky Land-Office Warrant, No 22683.

there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto *Grant Holloway* of *William Addison* of *William Butler* agent for the Monroe County Court.

a certain TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, containing *Ninety* acres, by

survey, bearing date the *25th* day *February* — one thousand eight hundred and *thirty three*

lying and being in the County of *Monroe* on the head waters of *Stiggs Creek* and bounded

as follows to wit Beginning on two buck trees, and a white oak thence *N 8° East* passing *John Harlands* corner on a white oak and two buck trees, at *14 poles* and with his line in all *86 poles* to a stake, corner to same thence *N 55° East 70 poles* to a stake, thence *S 35° East 20 poles* to a stake, thence *N 86° East 68 poles* to a black oak and gum thence *S 22° East 77 poles* to two gums thence *S 51° East 93 poles* to two buck trees, and two white oaks, the top of a fork of *Stiggs Creek* thence *N 74° West 69 poles* to the Beginning

and *his* — heirs forever.
