Quarantine

The State Board of Health has declared an absolute quarantine west of 18th street and north of Algonquin Parkway at sunrise February 1, 1937. Certain persons will be given passes thru the quarantine lines:

1. Doctor and nurses on duty in the quarantined area; ambulances.
 2. Workmen engaged in cleaning the quarantined area.
 3. Authorized sanitary inspectors.
 4. Workmen in industrial plants engaged in cleaning them preparatory to re-opening.
 5. Passengers and operators of public utilities who are not discharged within the quarantine area.
 6. Members of the Army and Police forces on duty in the quarantined area.
 7. Operators of trucks, boats, etc. carrying essential supplies.
- No passengers may be discharged from boats into the quarantined area.

A line of partial quarantine has been established outside the city limits, effective at sunrise January 31, 1937. Passes will be given to pass this line by the Jefferson County Health Dept. Passes to pass this line will be issued to bona fide residents of the unflooded area, trucks bringing in supplies or going out of town, and persons on definite business which will not take them into the zone of absolute quarantine.

Passes issued by the Director of Safety will be honored in passing from one section of the city to another where no quarantined area is involved.
