lawful money of Maryland to me in hand paid by William Orr
of the County and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknow-
-ledge and my self fully satisfied and paid, Have granted bargained
sold and made over, sold by the present, do grant bargain, sell
and make over unto the said William Orr his heirs and assigns
Forever One negro boy named Charles about twelve years of age
So Warrant and do Hold the said negro boy named Charles
with him the said William Orr his heirs and assigns forever

Given of the said County Writing for myself my heirs, executors
and assigns hereby do hereby Covenant and agree to warrant
and defend the said Negro boy named Charles unto him
the said William Orr his heirs and assigns against me and
my heirs, executors and assigns hereby again against all other
Persons whatever — In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal the second day of August
A.D. 1766 William Orr Mayor and Esquire
