All owners of Enrolled Slaves, are hereby notified to deliver the number below indicated to the undersigned Agents, in Greensburg, on Monday and Tuesday,--January, the 4th and 5th, 1863: each slave with a change of clothing and one blanket.

Those having from 1 to 3 will deliver one; from 3 to 5, will deliver two; from 5 to 7, will deliver three; and others in like proportion.
