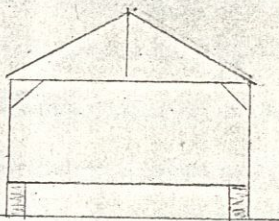

Scale 2 1/2 ft. to the inch.

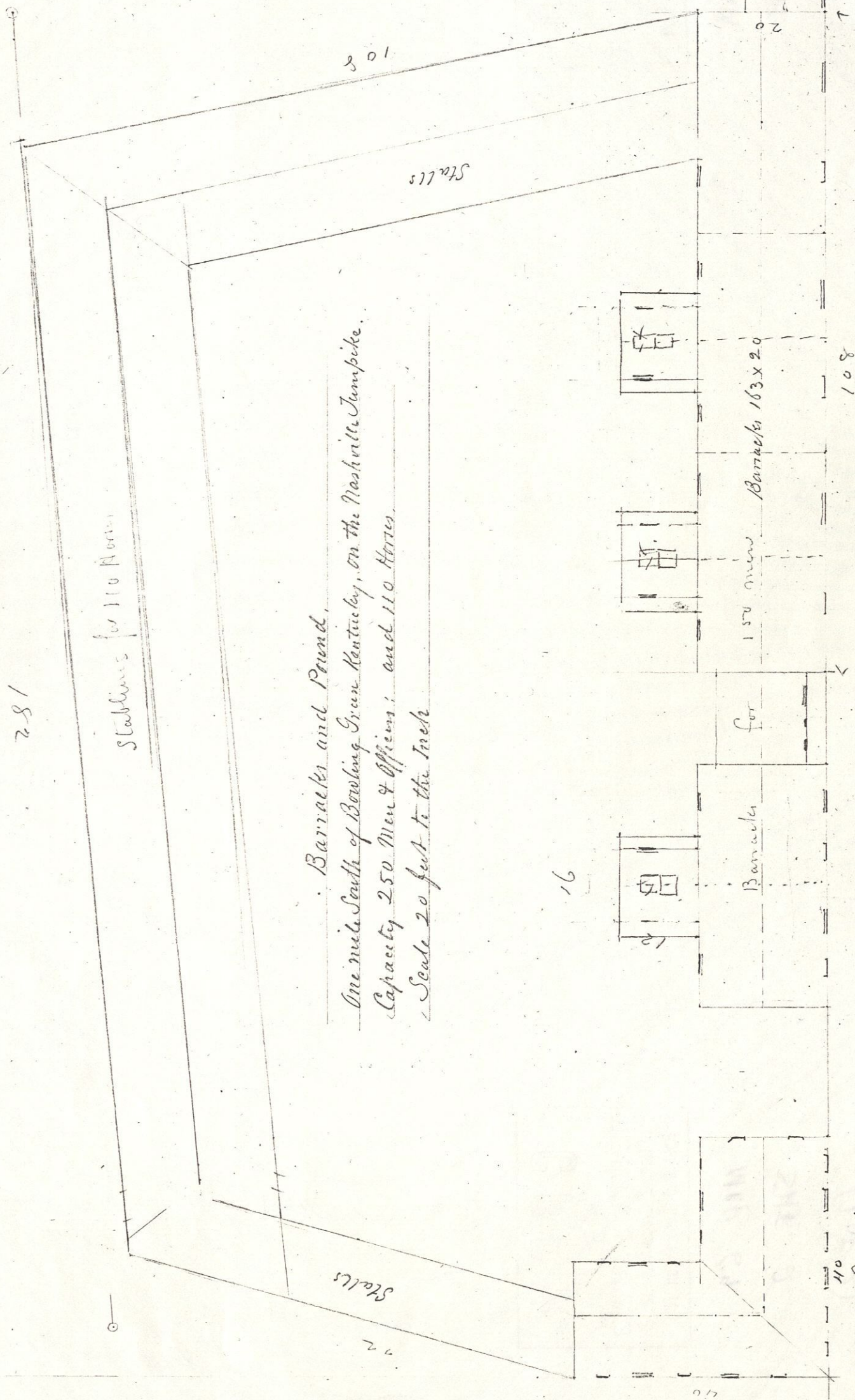

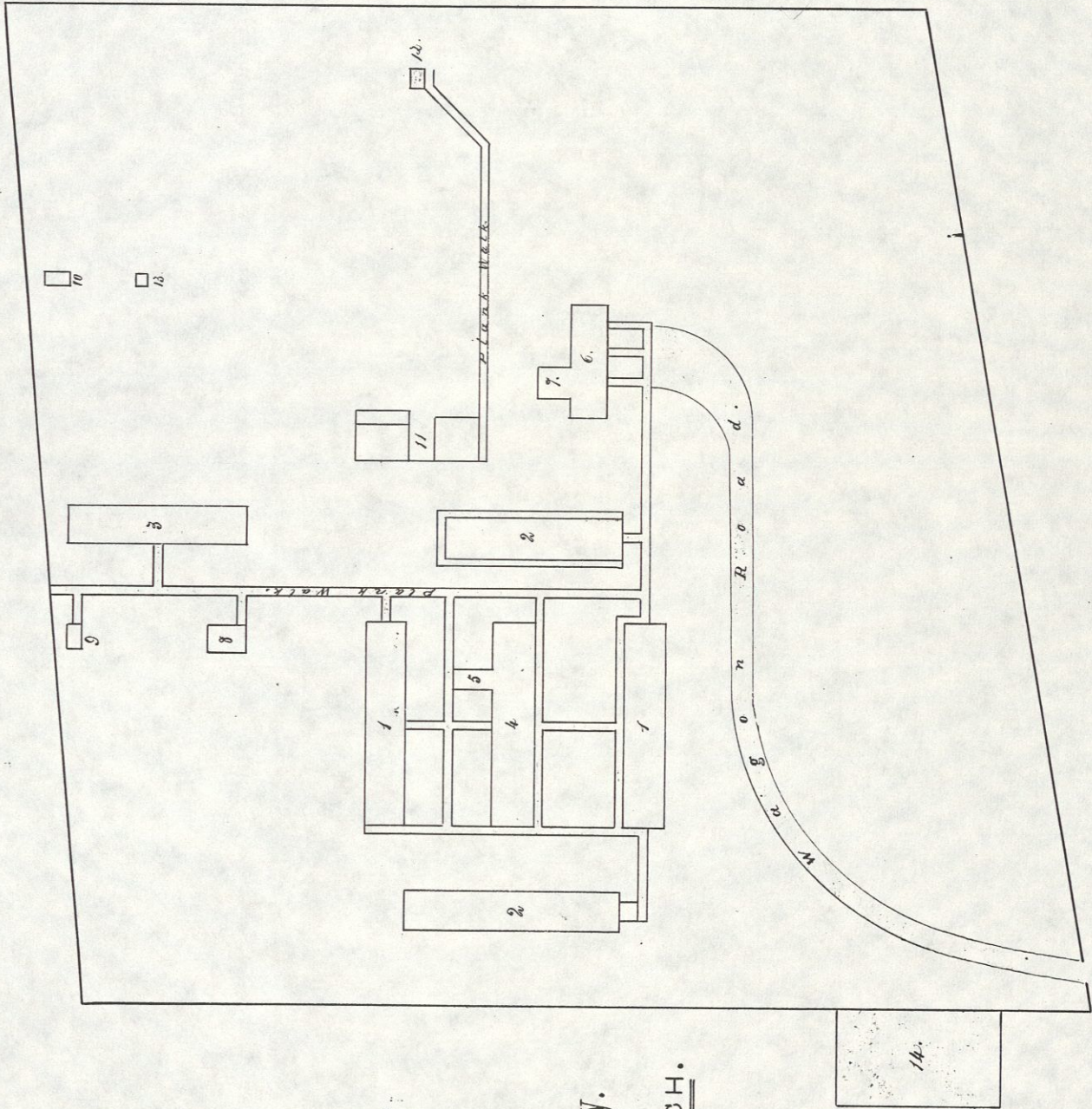
