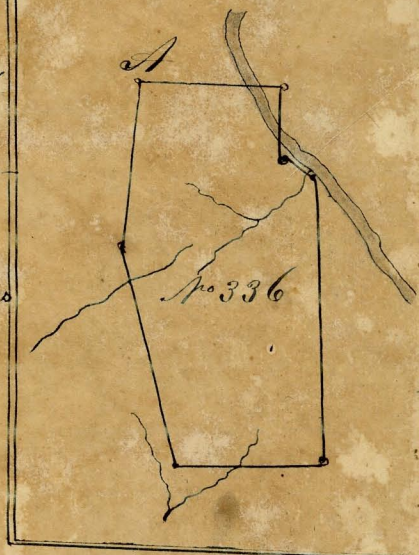


Surveyed for James Davis 400 acres by
 Virtue of a presumption warrant on the South
 Side of the back fork in Jefferson County Begin-
 ning at a cornered poplar and a mulberry tree
 standing in the North West line of Lower Severns
 presumption about 100 poles S. Easterly from Davis's
 Station running thence N 63° E 015 poles to a
 Spanish oak and honey locust crossing the Horse
 branch at 120 poles thence N 27° E 72 poles to a beech and
 sugar tree crossing the Horse branch at 45 poles thence N 40° W 46 poles to a beech
 by a drain thence N 20° E 294 poles to a mulberry thence N 70° E 15 poles to a
 white oak and white ash by a drain thence S 8° W 23 poles to Lower Severns
 presumption line and with said line S 27° W 175 poles to the Beginning
