TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME—GREETING:

KNOW YE, That by virtue and in consideration of *part of a Land Office Military Warrant*
N. 1923. issued the 21st day of November 1783

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto

William Croghan

a certain Tract or Parcel of LAND, containing *four hundred and fifty acres by Survey*
bearing date the 18th day of December 1783. lying and being in the
District set apart for the officers and soldiers of the Virginia State
line on the North side of Big Warren River and bounded as
followeth (To wit) Beginning at two white Oaks and hickory standing
on a high bank of the River about a mile below Drakes Creek and
three quarters of a mile below Andrew McAdams Ferry thence down
the River with its meanders S 71° W 27 poles S 26° W 20 poles S 83° W 50 poles
S 66° W 80 poles S 30° W 26 poles S 60° W 106 poles N 66° W 30 poles N 28° W 40 poles
N 28° poles N 27° W 30 poles North 120 poles N 20° W 22 poles N 5° E 20 poles North
10° W 48 poles N 10° W 35 poles to a large ash hackberry and beech standing
on the River bank a small distance above a bluff thence S 71° W 36 poles
to a stake thence S 92° poles to the Beginning (this is Part in the Original*
Survey)

With its appurtenances: To HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of LAND, with its appurtenances to the said

William Croghan

and *his* heirs forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The said *Edmund Randolph* Esq. Governor of
the Commonwealth of Virginia, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the lesser Seal of the
said Commonwealth to be affixed at *Richmond* on the *thirteenth* day of
April — in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and *eighty seven*
and of the Commonwealth the *eleventh*.
