

TO THE VOTERS OF EDMONSON COUNTY:

I am a candidate for County Attorney, and I am asking for the votes of the people of Edmonson County. The time is short, and I can not see all of the voters, and for that reason it is fitting that I let the people know where I stand on the great questions that confront us.

It is a most serious situation, and the people must be ready to select from the candidates those who will best serve them. The time is here when voters should act for the common good.

In the first place let me say that I was born and brought up on a farm in Edmonson County, and it has been my home all my life, except when I was away at school or in the Army. My life and my conduct is konw to all of those with whom I have come in contact, and to those who do not know me I invite them to search my record among my neighbors, my fellow church members and my fellow lodge members. There has been an effort for some years to obtain free text books for the public schools. The burden of purchasing school books has become too great for the individual to bear. At the coming Legislature I will go to Frankfort at my own expense and do what I can to have a bill passed which will compel the State to furnish, without expense, all text books in the public schools up to the eighth grade.

I stand for economy in the affairs of the county, It is the duty of the County Attorney to see that no public money is illegally expended, and I shall faithfully discharge my duty in this respect.

I stand for the best roads that we can secure with the money which we have, and it will be my purpose to see that all such money is judiciously expended.

The last and greatest thing for which I stand is the strict and impartial enforcement of the law against all alike who may violate it. While I will see to it that everyone has a square deal and that no innocent man shall be punished, still I want it understood that I shall give the best that is in me to the enforcement of the law to the end that Edmonson County shall be a place of law and order and fair dealing. The law is our only safeguard, and through it we must bring about the protection of all the people against the wrongdoer, and there can be no hesitañcy, and there will be none on my part, in enforcing the law against anyone who sets himself up against it.

I am not perfect, and I make mistakes, but now, having reached the mature age of thirty-five, it shall be my purpose at all times to serve my county and my fellow man.

I earnestly solicit the votes of all citizens who believe it is best for the county that I be elected County Attorney. I can only promise them, and then perform what I promise, that it shall be my purpose at all times to serve the people of the county inthe way that they should be served.
