## SESSION MINUTES.

January 12<sup>th</sup> 1919

The business before the Session was to consider the advisability of having the pulpit supplied during the interim of being without a pastor. It was decided best not to try anything definite until the winter months were past.

March 30<sup>th</sup> 1919

after a preaching service by the Rev. W-A Eckenbark of Bowling Green the Session convened.

Deacon Follen reported \$16.00 paid to Missions \$10.00 to the Home Board. Three Dollars to the Foreign Board and \$3.00 to the Board of Publication and S.S. Work. The Presbyterial dues were collected & turned over to the Presbyterial Treasurer. It was voted to endeavor to provide for preaching services twice each month if possible. It is worthy of record that elder Jno. W. Potter who is now past 83 yrs of age has been in the eldership of Trinity Church since the year 1871. Elder ~~Skiles~~ Skiles has served the Church for over 15 years. For many
