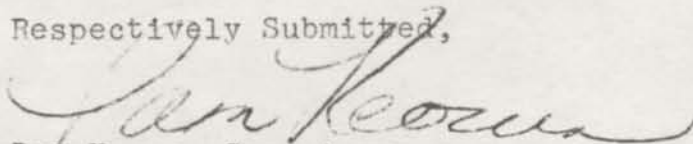

- Financial Dave Payne reported the present activities budget.
- Student Affairs Housing: Jeff Cashdollar announced he will be reporting to the Board of Regents in early February concerning 24-hour visitation policy and various related subjects.
- Academic Affairs Tim Leigh reported Academic Council met Thursday, January 27. Six new courses have been added and a new audit policy was accepted.
