

AGREEMENT RELATIVE TO DEPARTMENT DOMESTIC  
SCIENCE AND ARTS.

Bowling Green, Ky., January 3, 1911.

This agreement made and entered into by and Ellsworth Regenstein, H. K. Cole, E. H. Mark, C. W. Richards, and J. Whit Potter, members of the Board of Regents of the Western Kentucky State Normal School, Bowling Green, Kentucky, parties of the first part; and Dr. Wickliffe Rose, Executive Secretary of the Peabody Fund, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

The parties of the first part agree to establish in the Western Normal not later than April 4, 1911, a Department of Domestic Science and Domestic Arts, and to efficiently conduct and to permanently maintain the same. The Board of Regents further agrees to inaugurate such school policies as will bring the work in the Department of Domestic Science and Domestic Arts prominently before the people and to give it recognition in the regular and special courses of study offered by the institution. The Board agrees to do whatever is necessary to make the work of this Department efficient and far-reaching in its influence.

IN CONSIDERATION of the above agreement of the Board of Regents of the Western Kentucky State Normal, Dr. Wickliffe Rose, Executive Secretary of the Peabody Education Fund, agrees to donate \$2,000 to the Western Kentucky State Normal School to be used for the purchase of the physical equipment connected with the work of this nature. In consideration of the above agreement both parties have signed their names below.
