In addition, the History Department was home to an Afro-American History Club. No records from this club are currently housed in the archive. However, some information is listed in an Afro-American History program brochure. UA68/8/1

### **Stickles History Club**

Purpose: That the name and work of Dr. Stickles might be cherished, in the years to come, by students in the Western Kentucky Teachers College, and that those who wish to make history their major work might have opportunity for a broader field than can come from classroom recitation. Source: Minute Book 1, Page 1

The first formal meeting was on 11/01/1924. A minimum of 12 hours of history coursework was usually required to be eligible for membership. The Stickles History Club was very active. Their meeting programs included student presentations; history quiz bowls; roundtable discussions; presentations from faculty from a variety of departments including history, geography, political science, foreign language, military science, and more; presentations from off-campus guests including faculty at other universities, historical organizations, local citizens, political figures, and more; and, of course, regular updates on the significance of current events by Dr. Stickles for the first decades. They also had annual banquets with attendance approaching 100 at their peak; picnics; "watermelon feasts;" and other social events.

In the early 1970s, participation dwindled and the club was disbanded. In 1977, Karen Pryor and other students worked to restart the club and held an official meeting in January 1978.
