CULTURAL DIVERSITY --There was no report.

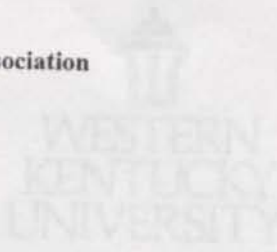
