***COLLECTION NOTES***

This collection consists of oral interviews, including cassette tapes and transcriptions, with sixteen World War II veterans; the men and women are from various service units and had a variety of military experiences. Many of the soldiers hailed from Ohio County, Kentucky. Frashure used the material collected from the interview to write her Honors thesis at Western Kentucky University, which was titled "Kentuckians at War: A Soldier's Perspective of World War II," which is included in the collection.
