***ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY***

In September 1865, the Auburn Presbyterian Church was organized by seventeen members in Logan County, Kentucky as the Auburn Society of Cumberland Presbyterians. The church gained admittance to the Logan Presbytery in October 1865.

Members first met in the school building in Auburn. The first church building was a frame structure built in 1867. A second church building, constructed of brick in 1900, burned in 1931; the third church building was constructed in 1932 on North Lincoln Street in Auburn.

***COLLECTION NOTE***

The collection consists of the minute books of Auburn Presbyterian Church, Logan County, Kentucky. The books cover 1865-1867 (Folder 2), 1869-1901 (Folder 3), 1901-1912 (Folder 4), 1912-1944 (Folder 5) and 1944-1957 (Folder 6). Where indicated in the shelf list below, the minute books include registers of pastors, elders, deacons, members, baptisms, deaths, marriages and removals, as well as minutes of church meetings.
