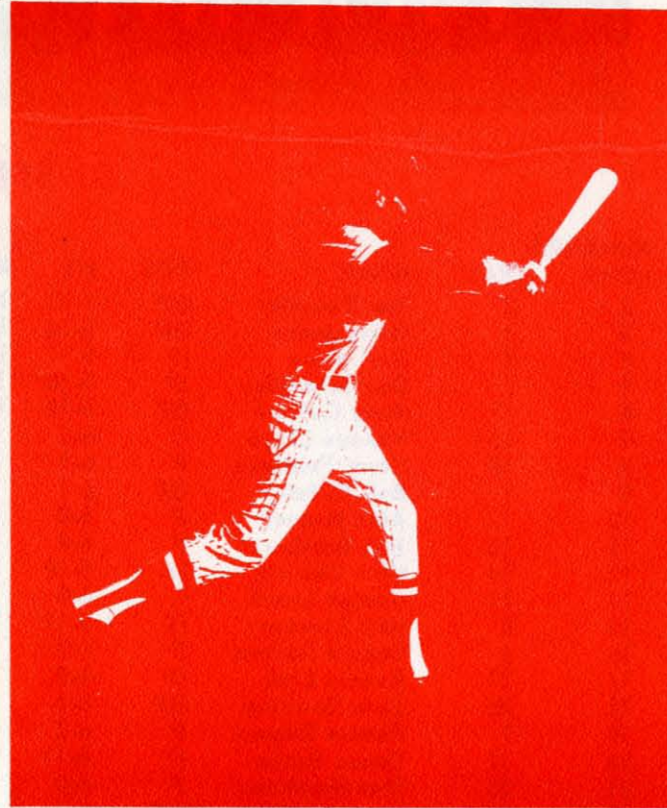

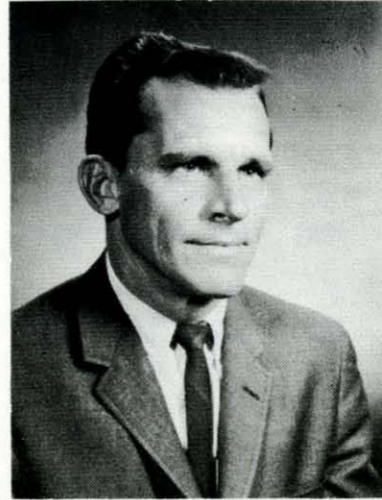

Coach JIM PICKENS



Jim Pickens is in his third season as head coach of the Hilltoppers. His background and experience fit him ably for the assignment.

The Princeton, Kentucky, native was a star pitcher, as well as an outstanding football quarterback, for Western Kentucky in his collegiate playing days. He later pitched professionally as a member of the Detroit Tigers' Organization.

Pickens came to Western as baseball coach in the fall of 1965 after a sparkling coaching career in the high school ranks, where he put together championship teams in both baseball and football. In six seasons at Bowling Green, High School, his baseball teams won 118 games while losing only 20, a percentage of .855. He climaxed his coaching stint there by guiding the Purples to the State Championship in 1965.

Prior to coaching at Bowling Green, Pickens held similar positions at Danville and Elizabethtown High Schools. Over a 15-year span, his high school diamond teams won 78.9 per cent of their games, racking up 221 victories against 59 losses.

Pickens' first two teams at Western have been inexperienced and beset with the lack of solid hitting punch. Nevertheless, his Hilltopper teams had a 22-27-2 record going into the current campaign, a creditable record for a beginning in a league where outstanding collegiate baseball is a tradition of long standing.

In addition to his coaching duties, Pickens is Assistant to the Director of Extension and Field Services. He received the B. S. and M. A. degrees from Western in 1951 and 1962, respectively.

He and his Wife, Ann, a former Hilltopper cheerleader, have one son, Jimmy Jr., 8.

1968 OUTLOOK

Western Kentucky's baseball should be ready to make a definite improvement this spring. More veteran players sprinkled throughout the roster and added pitching depth are the principal reasons for this optimistic outlook.

"We have eight pitchers to call on this spring," said Coach Jim Pickens, "as compared to only four last year. Since five of our losses last season were by only one run, you have to feel that more pitching depth could make a difference in our record."

The pitching staff is a blend of proven performers and newcomers and will be led by crafty lefthander Stan Markham, one of the Ohio Valley Conference's best.

Overall team speed and defense should both be better than in 1967. Frosh Phil Allen at short and established glove man Don Schneider at second base should anchor the infield. Bob Elliott, who led the team in hitting a year ago with a .327 mark, is the top returnee in the outfield.

The two big questions marks appear to be in catching and hitting. Last season's two top receivers, All-OVC Johnny Vance and Jim Vorhees, are gone (Vance because of a serious football injury; Vorhees to concentrate on spring football and his studies). Versatile Vanous Lloyd, who has played just about every position for the Hilltoppers, has been moved the plate.

As for hitting, only Elliott showed consistency in '67 but if Jim Bunnell, Lloyd, Schneider and others could regain some of the form they had in prior seasons, any possible problem would be eliminated.
